SAFETY - YARD SAFETY

In addition to safety rules for backyard swimming pools, in-ground or plastic wading pools, it is important to observe safety rules using other backyard equipment as well.

- 1. Keep children away from lawn mowers in use.
- 2. Make sure the area you are mowing is clear of stones, rocks, sticks, and other debris that could fly up at you as you mow.
- 3. Store gas for your mower in a safe place and away from curious children.
- 4. Do not let children ride with you on a riding mower.
- 5. Turn off the mower and wait for it to stop completely before you remove the grass catcher.
- 6. Learn to identify poison ivy and avoid it. Teach children to stay away from it also.
- 7. If you have a swing set in your yard, be sure it is sturdy and in good condition.
- 8. Make sure the swing set is appropriate for the size and weight of your children.
- 9. Be sure all play equipment is stable on the ground.
- 10. Avoid play equipment with open "s" hooks or exposed screws or bolts.
- 11. Avoid equipment with parts that could pinch or trap parts of the body.
- 12. Surround the play equipment with a soft surface like wood chips, mulch, sand, etc. Consult manufacturer's instructions for recommended materials and depths and maintain the surface you put down regularly.
- 13. Supervise children on play equipment.
- 14. Follow good sense regarding heat and sun safety rules.

Note: Play equipment rules apply to the neighborhood playground also.
